To celebrate and give everyone an opportunity to meet Pastor Michelle in person, we moved to the Activity Center where the Worship Board had punch and cake waiting.

As I mentioned above, it has been a long process and at times it seemed we would never get to this place. But it was all worth the effort. The process worked and we can feel confident that we have found someone who wants to lead us and who we are all anxious to get to know.

Pastor Michelle will join us on July 2nd; her first service will be July 8th. Her formal installation will be in early fall.

I've listed the teams on the next page that took part in this process. If you have a chance, and you see one of these folks, thank them for all the time and work they did to bring us to where we are today. They truly deserve our heartfelt thanks.

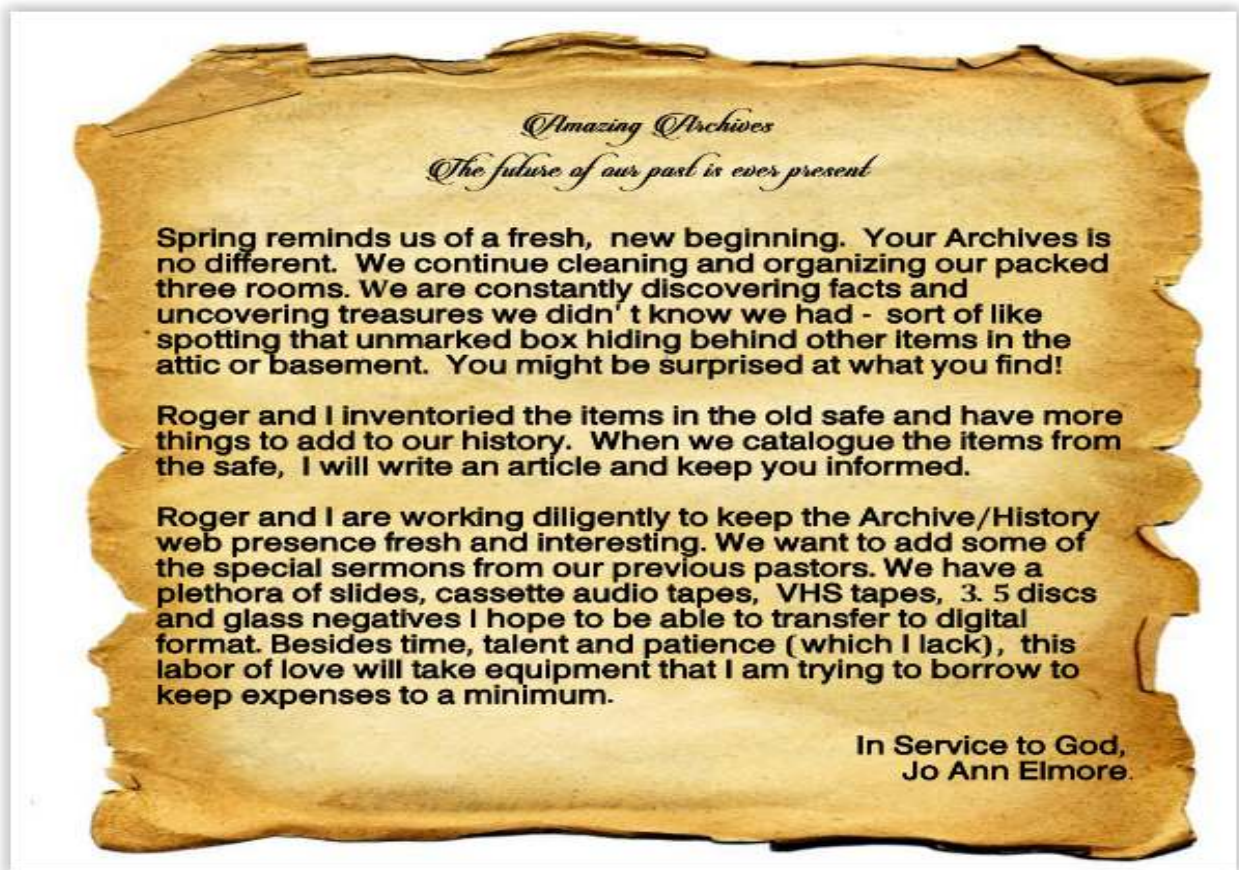
