And with this overabundance of feelings comes an overabundance of reactions. Some are healthy. Others hurt.


Forgive us for acting out of our grief.

History with Henke

April 1, 1857 - The Church school was officially closed. The public school system was introduced in Belleville in 1856. The St. Paul Board arranged to rent the church (school) building to the public school board for one year. This action eliminated the need of Rev. Lepique who was the school teacher.

April 14, 1860 - It was definitely decided by the congregation to build the second church which would be constructed of brick and would be larger. This is the site of the Heritage Hall and the chapel. The chapel was to cost \$4,271.21.

April 16, 1918 - A hailstorm caused thousands of dollars worth of damage in the Belleville area. The large stained glass window (St. Paul Window) in the front of the church and several smaller stained glass windows were punctured with hundreds of small holes. The cost of repairing these windows was \$300.
