
This has been a time for us to listen to the ways that God is asking us to be creative in ministry, communication, and care. What is God asking us to do next? How can we be the bearers of hope?


We give thanks for God's calling and for the treasures, time, and talents provided by God. With gratitude, we pray together:

Oct 25, 1862 - A ball with a concert was given to raise money for the church debt. A profit of \$301.50 was realized from this affair and it became an annual event during the early years.

Oct 30, 1892 - A literary society, later known as the Women's Union, was organized by Rev. Weber.

Oct, 1925 - Publication of the first "Our St. Paul's" newsletter took place.
