At the church service., the honorable Alfred D. Riess, Circuit Judge and grandson of the first pastor, was the speaker. At the afternoon community service, the speakers were Rev. Arthur Limper, Pres of Illinois South District; Judge Riess, and Professor Schneider. At the evening jubilee service, the addresses were given by Rev Ludwig C Kutz, former associate pastor and only living ex-resident pastor, and Lee Rockwell, St Paul senior student at Eden Seminary.
