#### ALL SAINTS DAY PRAYER OF COMMUNION

<u>Excerpt from St Paul UCC - History of our First Church 1839-1860</u> Riess closed his connections with Belleville October 9, 1839. The following short paragraph was taken from his diary. "Preacher William Flickinger took over my congregations in Belleville and Turkey Hill."
