





#### History with Henke

Our second pastor: Wilhelm (William) Flickinger Flickinger was born April 7, 1808 in Zweibrucken Rheinbavaria. He graduated with a degree in theology from the University of Erlangen in Germany. Flickinger, like many other Germans, was forcefully encouraged to leave his homeland because his political viewpoint was in support of the first democratic government movement in Germany. He immigrated to America arriving in St. Clair County in the early 1800s.
