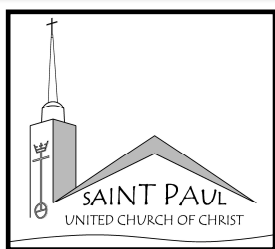
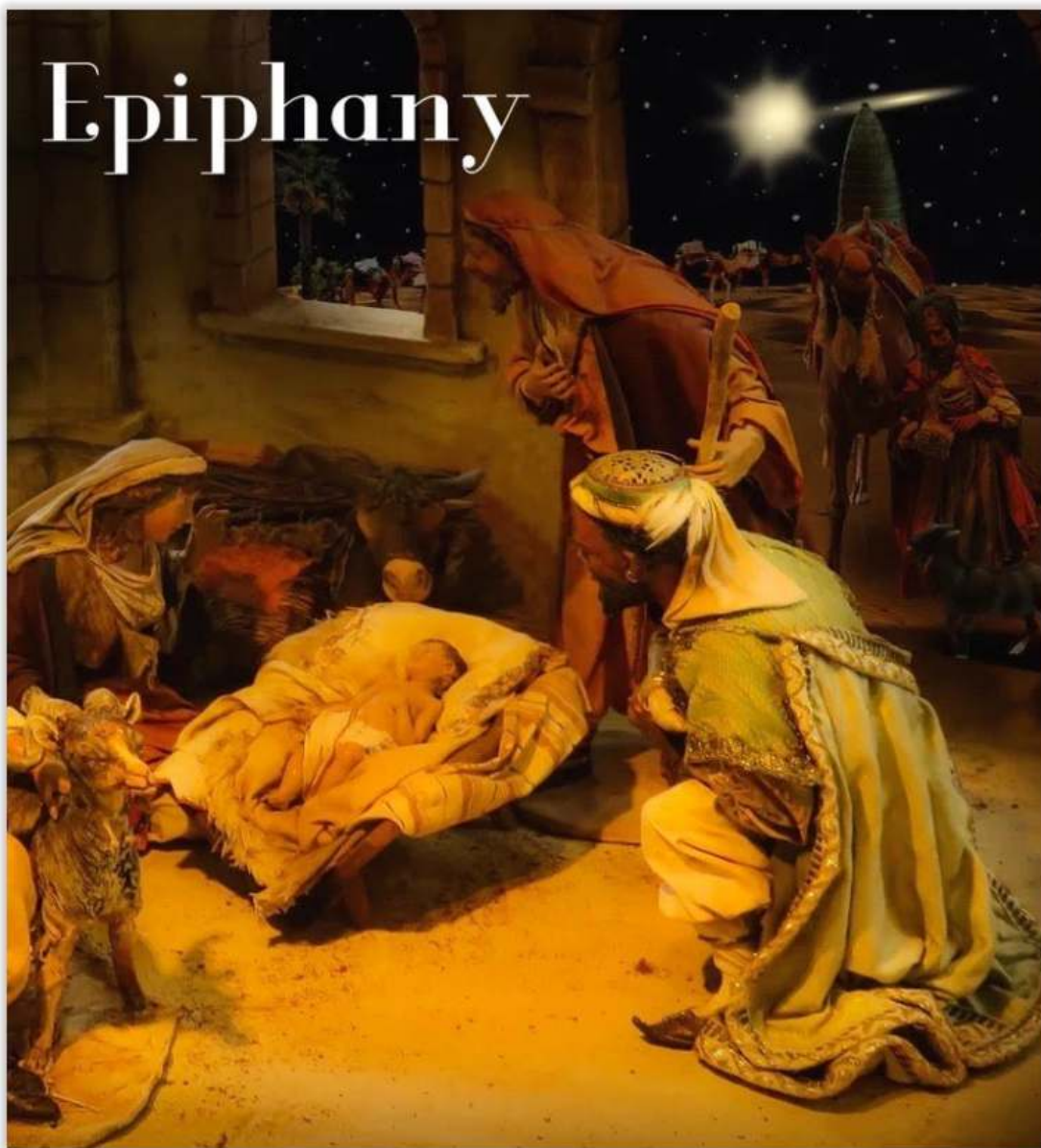

Which will shine through the end of time.


INVOCATION



Prayer of Thanksgiving

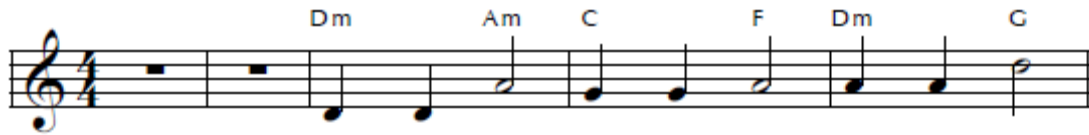

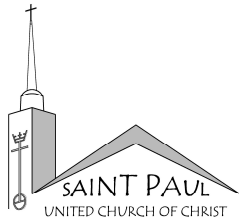
BENEDICTION

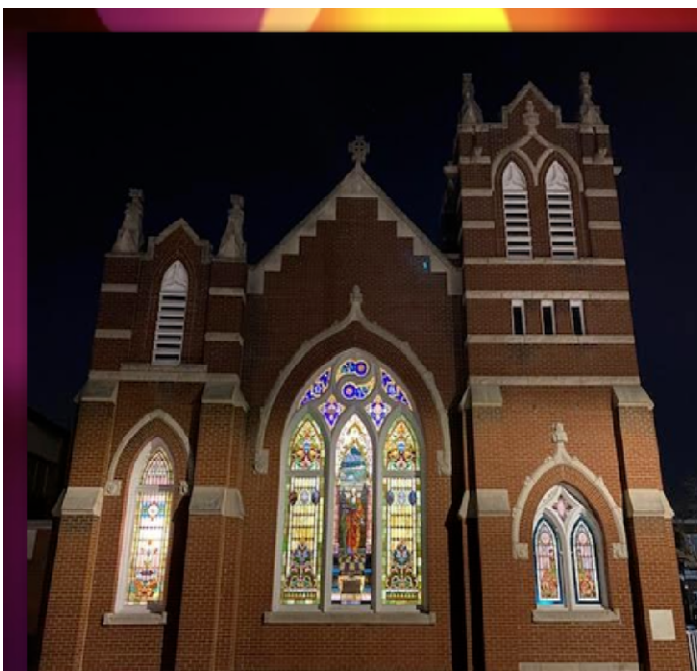
