A Message from the Pastor and Council President about our upcoming Special Congregational Meeting on June 6

Dear St. Paul Friends,

This past year has been a unique challenge for many congregations. Not only did we have to experience time away from each other, but we are challenged with the continuing uphill struggle that comes with growing a Mainline Protestant church.

As we regather, we are reevaluating our various programs to see how we can best serve the people of our congregation and reach out to our community.

One of these conversations is the improvement of our technological system at St. Paul UCC.

Our time in quarantine forced us to focus our attention on using new forms of technology to keep connected to our congregants. Through the work of our staff and volunteers, we have been able to establish streaming services with the tools that we had on hand during a crucial time.

Like with the radio, many people are now streaming our worship services on their phones, iPad tablets, computers, and televisions. Not only do we have congregants who cannot be with us on Sunday mornings watching on Facebook, our website, or YouTube, but we also have people who have no connection to St. Paul watch our services as well.

As we continue our in person worship on Sunday mornings, we know that many of you will still sometimes watch our services from home at your convenience, when you are on vacation, when you are recovering from an illness, or when you have other plans on a Sunday morning. And we want to give you the most optimal worship experience possible whether you are worshipping remotely or in person.

Our goal is to upgrade our technology to improve not only the worship experience inside the sanctuary, but also for the ones who watch our streaming service on video at home.

On June 6, we will have a special congregational meeting to present a plan to restructure our technological system at St. Paul. Our staff and volunteers have devoted much time to gather this information. Included in our proposal is to improve the audio/visual streaming system, the sound system, the lighting in the sanctuary, and a half-time tech position. We will also discuss restoring the use of the bells in the bell tower and improving the acoustics in Heritage Hall. This proposal is approximately \$200,000. We will discuss how to best fund this, including a withdrawal from the Endowment Fund.

We hope that you can attend this meeting either in person or through Zoom.

Like some of our neighboring churches, we realize how much we need these programs to be a relevant church for the twenty-first century. And we are called to keep up with the technology of our time in order to follow Jesus' request to "Go into all the world and proclaim the good news to the whole creation." (Mark 16:15 NRSV). We look forward to having this conversation and making plans with you on June 6.





Current Covid-19 Guidelines at St. Paul UCC

The past and current Covid-19 safety guidelines at St. Paul take into account all of our congregants, including our children and the most vulnerable. With this in mind, the following are updated guidelines:

- * We will not be taking temperatures from this point forward or registering for the 9am services.
- * We have room for 100 at each indoor service.

* We are no longer requiring masks at our outdoor worship. Masks continue to be encouraged, especially when group singing. We also ask that we continue to practice distancing.

* We **highly encourage masks** at our indoor services which includes worship, weddings, funerals, etc. and ask that people who are not vaccinated to wear one. We look to start congregational singing during the month of June, and this will help us comfortably start the process. Again, we ask that we continue to practice distancing.

* Masks will be required by both adults and youth wherever youth are present (as many 12-15 year olds still aren't fully vaccinated and vaccines aren't available to those under 12). We will require masks for all adults and youth at VBS in June.

* With groups approximately 15 or less, if all have been vaccinated, the members are not required to wear masks. Masks are always encouraged, especially for those who have underlying health conditions.

This updated list of guidelines will continue to be evaluated and updated as needed with the guidance of our regathering team and executive council. Thank you for all that you have done and continue to do to ensure this pandemic comes to an end and for your patience as we navigate what we hope are the final months of this pandemic.
