Pastor's Message A Season of Joy

On the Sunday following Pentecost the liturgical season of Ordinary Time begins. Sometimes you see the season is noted as the "Season of Pentecost." No matter what this liturgical season is called, it really isn't as expectedly fancy as the seasons of Christmas, Epiphany, or Easter. It's not as jazzy and bright as Pentecost itself. And it isn't a time of focused reflection like Lent or Advent. It's Ordinary Time.

Ordinary is often felt as filler, plain, and to some boring. We can often use the word "everyday" interchangeably with ordinary. But I see it in very different ways.

We pastors often take this opportunity to shift our focus on the spectacular within the ordinary. Whether it's a sermon series focused on the gospel of the liturgical year or a special theme, we try to bring our attention from the everyday to the holy.

Most of us live as if each day is ordinary. We get up, drink some coffee, go about our business, eat our meals, socialize with loved ones in the evening, and go to sleep. But within the patterns of everyday life, there are sparkles of beauty. There are moments to celebrate.

This isn't a "everyone gets a trophy" situation - not that I think there's anything wrong with participation awards. Completing a task or a season is most often a reason itself to celebrate - especially as physical, emotional, and spiritual challenges plague us. But I believe God wants us to rejoice in our small and large accomplishments along the way. Often, we delight in silence instead of exclaiming our joy as we should.

So during this season which is known as ordinary, we are going to illuminate the joys and celebrate! From June 3 through July 21, we will have the Season of Joy sermon series. During these services, we will be recognizing graduates in our congregation and families. We will be celebrating Rev. Dr. Chance Beeler's four-way covenant as a St. Elizabeth's Hospital Chaplain. And as all of this is in 2024, we continue to celebrate 185 years St. Paul UCC has been a part of the Belleville community!

Be ready to share your joys, celebrations, and accomplishments. We will continue to announce them during the announcements along with birthdays and anniversaries.

We see how demanding, troublesome, and brief life can be. We see how speedy days fly by and how we miss sharing our greetings of congratulations with one another. In this season, let us find every opportunity to find our bliss and share our joy with one another!

Important announcement regarding the radio broadcast of our Sunday morning service



This letter has gone to our congregants who are worship through the radio and announced in worship and in our eNews throughout the month of June.

Dear Friends,

St. Paul began broadcasting our Sunday morning worship services via the radio on July 11, 1948. Our radio ministry has been an important ministry for us since not everyone can attend a church service in person, and we are grateful for the many ways it has connected with our members and neighbors for so many years.

In recent years, the Covid pandemic forced us to cancel in-person worship services for an extended period. Our situation during the Covid pandemic forced us to think about alternative ways we could deliver a worship experience to our congregation. We decided the Covid pandemic was an opportunity for us to begin streaming our worship services and other events across the internet on the social media site Facebook, on the video-streaming site YouTube, and on our own website StPaulUCC.org.

The number of radio listeners began to dwindle over the years even before the Covid pandemic. Currently, there are just a few members that listen to our radio broadcast on a regular basis. The Church Council has discussed ending the radio broadcast for the past few years due to the resources it takes to provide this service. After many conversations, the Council has decided that now is the time to end our radio ministry and focus on other means to provide worship services to those who cannot attend church in person. Sunday May 26th was the date of our last radio broadcast.

We know this may be difficult news to hear. Our hope is that we can find ways to continue to connect with you even after the radio ministry has ended. 
