

PRELUDE

CALL TO WORSHIP (Inspired by Psalm 146)

One: Praise the Holy One as long as we live.

Many: Praise the Creator, who makes our days, who trails our paths, and who gives us breath.

One: Praise the Holy One with our whole selves—mind, body, and soul. Many: Trust in wisdom and honor, truth and love, grace and mercy.

One: Praise the Holy One for God is just, generous, compassionate, liberating, and near.

Many: The Holy One reigns, lifting up the lowly, humbling, the proud, and sustaining the righteous from generation to generation. Praise God!

INVOCATION (Unison)

Write care and wholeness of those with unmet needs and revelation and understanding to those oblivious to the truth. Emblazon your law of love in our hearts, on our lips, and in our journey. Transform us with your love so that we may reflect your love toward our neighbor and toward ourselves. Amen.

*ASSURANCE OF GRACE

Beloved, you are loved, and you have power to choose love in every moment and every encounter. Love has the power to lift, to heal, and to change. Let Holy Love move the mountains before you and the valleys within you.

TOTENFEST SERVICE

Totenfest is a word created by the Evangelical church when it was formed in 19th century Prussia. The word refers to the liturgical remembrance of those who have died in the preceding year.

Holy God, meet us here in this place as we mourn those who have died this year-children, parents, aunts and uncles, siblings and grandparents, spouses, significant others and friends.

Names of our loved ones who have died in the past year that we have included in the insert will now be read. As the names are read, a bell will ring in memory of the one who has died.

Holy God of wind and fire: dance through this room today. Holy God of earthquakes and illness: share our tears of sadness and pain. Holy God of creation and new beginnings: show us again your vision of healing and wholeness.




